Best practices are just that—highly recommended, but no longer enforced through punitive or corrective actions by the association. There will be no continuing nor ongoing NACAC-imposed sanctions for actions which deviate from suggested best practices.

Ongoing practices are no longer prescriptive but continue to focus on actions which support and protect student choice throughout the college admission process.

Resource documents and advising will focus firmly upon education, training, collegial communication and collaboration, and actions which support the needs and protection of students throughout the college admission process.
